You are invited to attend the Chapter's Annual meeting and tour "**The Historic Cavanagh Adobe**" which was the restored by Michael Burch Architects, which are the the current owners.

Construction on this property started in 1922 by brothers, Albert and Hubert "Bert" Cavanagh, early Coachella Valley pioneers and was designed by architect H. Anderson Sanders. The Cavanagh adobe is one of the oldest homes in the Coachella Valley and one of the few adobes still standing. Bert Cavanagh was one of the founders of the City of Indian Wells and one-time Mayor. Along with the tour will be a talk by Michael Burch, AIA of Michael Burch Architects, an internationally acclaimed, award-winning firm, specializing in the Spanish Colonial Revival Style. His talk which is based on research funded by the Getty Foundation and will take you on a whirlwind tour through the Golden age of Californian architecture, its nadir, and 100 years later, its revival with A Return to Authenticity. Examples of structures in Redlands and Palm Springs will be used to explore the rich history of architecture in Southern California. Throughout the talk, attitudes towards architectural style will be referenced as to how these styles are portrayed in film and the role of Hollywood in the shaping of architectural taste.
